Our welcome and instructions to media representatives

Thank you for registering to attend the 2021 Fukushima Medical University International Symposium on the Fukushima Health Management Survey. In consideration of COVID-19, this symposium will be held mainly for remote online viewing, without a general audience on site. At the venue, we will implement thorough countermeasures, but everyone's cooperation is needed and we must ask you to observe the following:

- Start and continue checking the health status of yourself and the people who live with you from 30 January. Download and install the COVID-19 Contact Confirming Application (COCOA) on a smart device that you always carry with you. Also, please wear a mask properly while in the venue, and follow social distancing guidelines and other instructions.
- If your body temperature is 37.5 degrees Celsius or higher according to the thermal camera at the venue entrance, you will be requested to provide your name and to have another measurement taken by our medical staff, using a non-contact thermometer. If that result is also at or above 37.5 degrees Celsius, you may be denied entry, but will be offered an explanation of infection risk by an on-site authority.
- If a state of emergency has been declared in other prefectures, those from affected regions, especially if behaviors and health status over the prior 2 weeks cannot be verified, may be denied entry.
- Please wash or sanitize your hands frequently when entering/leaving the venue, and refrain from talking while eating (eating in the venue is not allowed).
- If you are found to be infected with COVID-19 after attending our symposium, please immediately contact the Office of International Cooperation, Radiation Medical Science Center for the Fukushima Health Management Survery, Fukushima Medical University (phone as noted below).
